

GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION CODE: EGECE DURATION: 1 YEAR CAMPUS: ONLINE vu.edu.au/courses/egece	Enhance your career options with VU's one-year, online Graduate Diploma of Early Childhood Education, which allows graduates of degree programs to become kindergarten teachers or early-childhood educators. Units are focused on birth to five years, learning how teaching practice can include children and families as capable participants in education. You'll also complete 60 days of supervised professional experience – an excellent opportunity for the consolidation of core knowledge. This course is accredited by Australian Children's Education & Care Quality Authority.	Completion of an Australian Bachelor degree (or equivalent) in the same discipline.	Public or private kindergartens, long day care centres, early childhood centres in the state of Victoria, Australia.
MASTER OF TEACHING (PRIMARY EDUCATION) CODE: EMPE DURATION: 2 YEARS CAMPUS: FOOTSCRAY PARK vu.edu.au/courses/empe	Gain practical experience and prepare for a rewarding career as a primary school teacher. Refine your craft by engaging in classroom discussions and undertaking research. You will also gain significant workplace experience to prepare you for the real world through 60 days of supervised teaching practice in a primary school.	Completion of an Australian Bachelor degree or equivalent.	Primary school teacher.
MASTER OF TEACHING (SECONDARY EDUCATION) CODE: EMES DURATION: 2 YEARS CAMPUS: FOOTSCRAY PARK vu.edu.au/courses/emes	The Master of Teaching (Secondary) is a two-year full-time postgraduate program designed to prepare students for registration as secondary teachers. This course involves significant learning in the workplace through project partnerships and prepares for teaching in a wide range of disciplines, including business, English, health, mathematics, physical education, science and technology.	Completion of an Australian Bachelor degree (or equivalent) in a discipline that meets VIT specialisation requirements.	Secondary teacher, roles with a range of educational-related industries and organisations.
GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN TESOL CODE: ATTL DURATION: 0.5 YEARS PART TIME CAMPUS: FOOTSCRAY PARK vu.edu.au/courses/attl	Expand your employment opportunities and become qualified to teach English as an additional language (EAL) with the Graduate Certificate in TESOL. The course is designed for teachers who want to develop their professional practice in Teaching English to Speakers of other Languages (TESOL). You will strengthen your current skills and gain a solid understanding of the principles and approaches to TESOL, including curriculum design and evaluation.	Completion of an Australian Bachelor degree (or equivalent) in a similar discipline OR Applicants with a minimum two years' approved work experience will be considered for admission to this course.	Graduates will be equipped as a TESOL program designer and teacher in a range of educational and training contexts such as: - working with migrants or indigenous students at the primary, secondary or adult level - teaching English abroad.

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN EDUCATION CODE: ETED DURATION: 0.5 YEARS CAMPUS: FOOTSCRAY PARK vu.edu.au/courses/eted	Gain an advanced knowledge of the theory and practice of learning and teaching that meets the growing need for educational expertise within the education sector, community, government and industry. You will learn from experienced educators and study contemporary theories in learning, leadership and managing the dynamic education environment, through practitioner research.	Completion of an Australian Bachelor degree (or equivalent) in a similar discipline. OR A minimum five (5) years approved work experience will be considered for admission to this course.	Education professionals, specialist managers, health professionals. Note: this course does not provide students with registration to teach.
GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION CODE: EGED DURATION: 1 YEAR CAMPUS: FOOTSCRAY PARK vu.edu.au/courses/eged	Gain advanced knowledge and skills for further learning and professional work in education or training. You will engage in professional learning through practitioner research informed by contemporary theories of learning, leadership and personal, workplace and social change.	Completion of an Australian Bachelor degree (or equivalent) in any discipline, or Graduate Diploma (or equivalent) in a similar discipline. If you don't meet the entry requirements, you may be admitted to the Graduate Diploma based on approved work experience. Once completed, you may be eligible for admission to this course.	Education or health professional, preparation for a management role in a number of specialist fields. Note: this course does not provide students with registration to teach.
MASTER OF EDUCATION CODE: HRED DURATION: 2 YEARS CAMPUS: FOOTSCRAY PARK vu.edu.au/courses/hred	Make a valuable contribution to new knowledge in the field of education as you make yourself more competitive in your career. Manage a research project with the support of academics with broad research experience, including presenting papers at international conferences and publishing papers in academic journals and books.	Undergraduate degree completed at a high standard (normally distinction average in final year); or relevant qualification at an appropriate standard plus professional experience.	Professional development for teachers, education administrators, researchers and policy makers. Note: this course does not provide students with registration to teach.
MASTER OF EDUCATION CODE: EMED DURATION: 2 YEARS CAMPUS: FOOTSCRAY PARK vu.edu.au/courses/emed	Build on your experience as an educator by studying the latest theory and research in education. This flexible coursework program has a particular focus on, and commitment to, social justice, sustainability and ethical action. It is designed to meet the needs of professionals whose work has an educational component or some educational responsibility.	Completion of an Australian Bachelor degree (or equivalent) in any discipline, or Graduate Diploma (or equivalent) in a similar discipline. If you don't meet the entry requirements, you may be admitted to the Graduate Diploma based on approved work experience. Once completed, you may be eligible for admission to this course.	Education professional, specialist manager, health professional. Increasingly, a Master of Education is seen as a prerequisite for promotion in the field of education for qualified school teachers.
